1. Engagement

2. Compensation

- The Artist shall be paid a total fee of **\$2000.00** for the performance, payable as follows:
 - **Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of **\$300.00** is due upon signing this agreement to confirm the booking.

 - **Balance:** The remaining balance of **\$1700.00** is due on the day of the performance, prior to the start of the event.

3. Travel and Accommodation

- **Travel Expenses:** The Venue shall not cover or reimburse travel expenses if applicable (included.). _____ initial. **NOT APPLICABLE!**
- **Accommodation:** If the performance requires overnight stay, the Venue will provide or reimburse for one night of Motel / Hotel accommodation. Two (2) Motel / Hotel rooms with double beds with breakfast at a mutually agreed location. _____ initial. **NOT APPLICABLE!**

4. Technical Requirements

- The Artist shall provide a detailed list of technical requirements for the performance, including sound, lighting, and equipment needs. The Venue agrees to ensure these requirements are met or will consult with the Artist to make alternate arrangements.
- Any equipment provided by the Artist, including instruments and sound gear, will be at the Venues own risk. _____ initial. DI BOX and Guitar Cord

5. Cancellations and Rescheduling

- **Artist Cancellation:** If the Artist is unable to perform due to illness or other unforeseen circumstances, the Artist shall notify the Venue at least [Insert number] days before the event. A full refund of any deposit paid will be issued if the Artist is unable to fulfill the engagement.
- **Venue Cancellation:** If the Venue cancels the performance, the Venue agrees to notify the Artist as soon as possible. If cancellation occurs less than [Insert number] days before the event, the Artist is entitled to a full payment of the agreed-upon fee.
- **Force Majeure:** Neither party shall be held liable for failure to perform due to circumstances beyond their reasonable control (e.g., acts of God, natural disasters, public health emergencies, etc.).

6. Promotion and Marketing

- The Venue agrees to promote the event, including but not limited to social media, posters, email newsletters, and website listings.
- The Artist grants the Venue the right to use the Artist's name, image, and likeness for promotional purposes related to the event, subject to prior approval by the Artist.

7. Soundcheck and Performance Time

- The Artist will arrive at the Venue 2 hours prior to the start of the event for soundcheck and setup.

- The Artist agrees to perform during the agreed time, and any changes to the scheduled performance time must be mutually agreed upon by both parties in writing.

8. Liability and Insurance

- The Artist shall not be held responsible for any injury, damage, or loss arising from their performance.
- The Venue is responsible for providing necessary insurance to cover any damages or accidents occurring on the Venue's property during the event.
- The Venue is responsible for providing necessary insurance to cover any damages to live sound equipment belonging to the act and band in this contract.
- The Venue agrees to maintain their own insurance. _____ initial.
- The Venue agrees to maintain their own insurance.

9. Conduct and Behavior

- The Artist agrees to always conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and during the event.
- The Venue reserves the right to terminate the performance immediately if the Artist engages in any behavior deemed inappropriate, illegal, or in violation of the Venue's policies.

10. Indemnification

- The Venue agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Artist from any claims, damages, or losses arising from the Venue's actions or negligence during the performance.
- The Artist agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Venue from any claims, damages, or losses arising from the Artist's actions or negligence during the performance.
